

Displaying a formula in cells

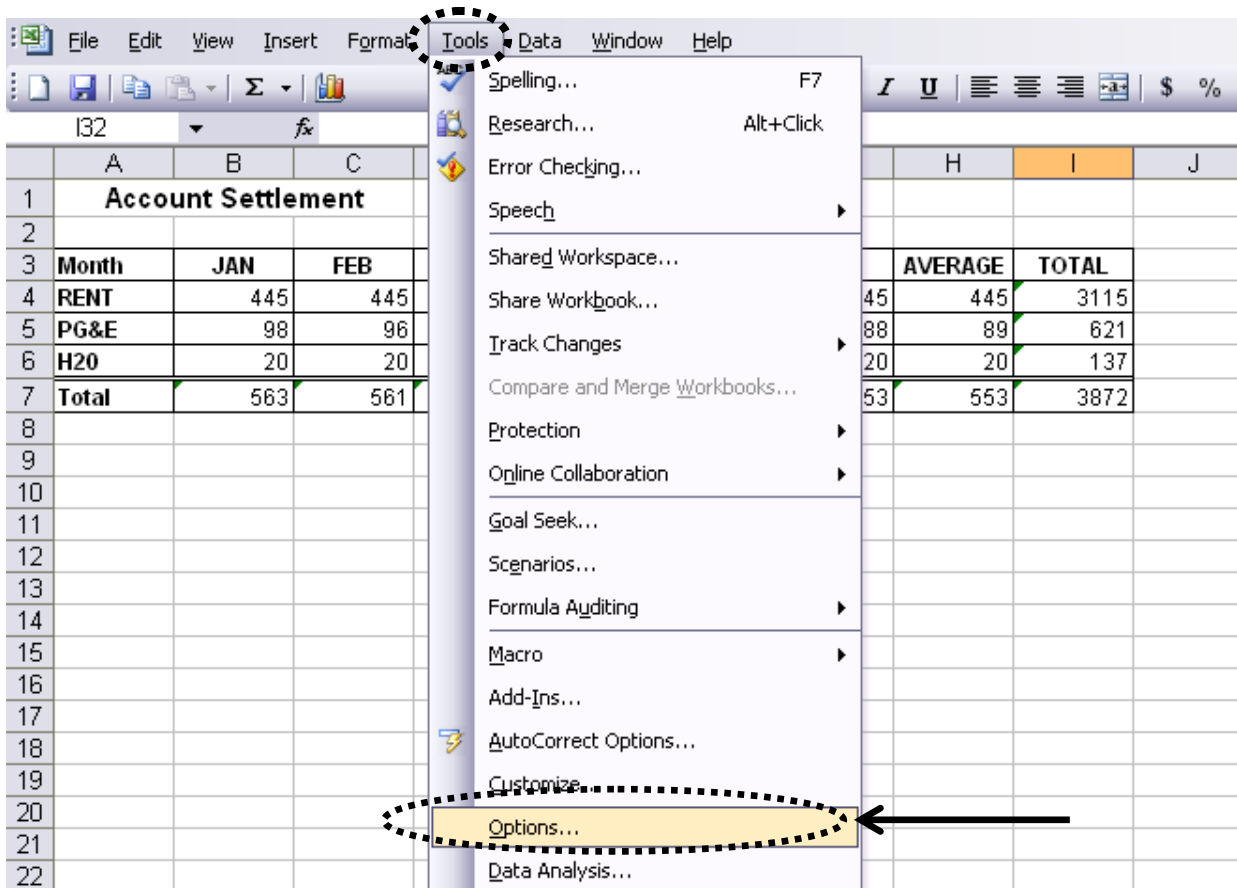

You may wish to display the script of a formula contained in a particular cell to show how you performed your calculation.

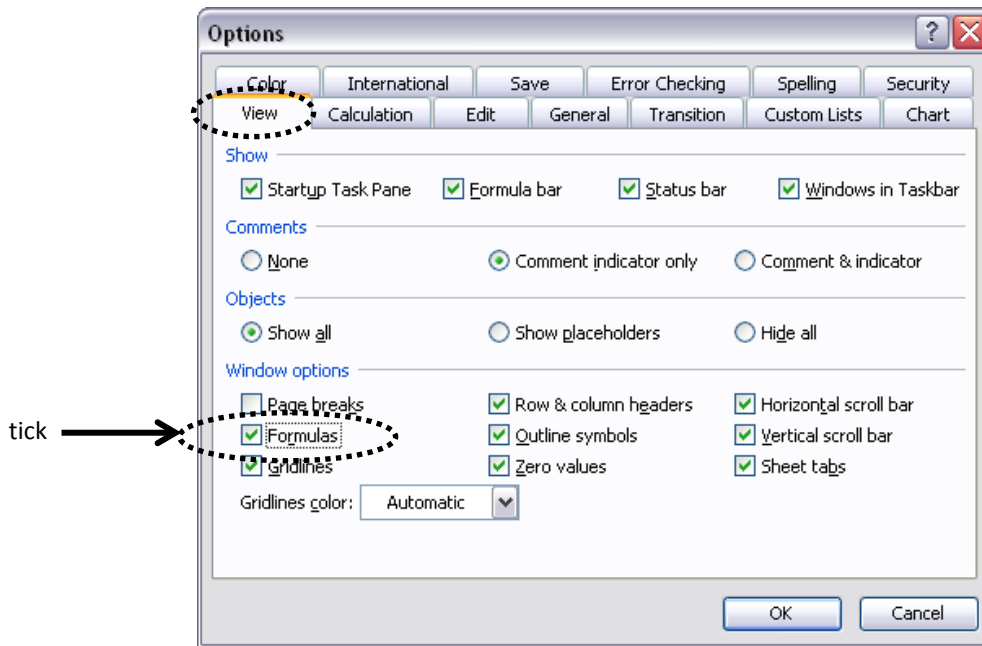
e.g.) Sample data – **TOTAL** cells contain formulas (cells are greyed).

2. Tick on the **Formulas** box in the **View** tab > Click **OK**

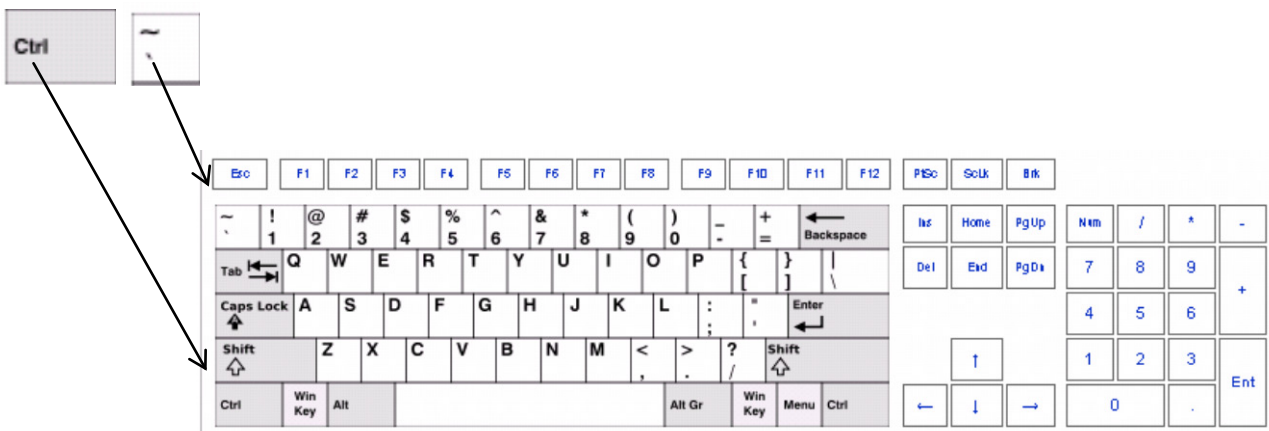
