

Modifying a pie chart



This is useful if you have a data series that you wish to make stand out.


Sample data:

	Qtr 1	Qtr 2	Qtr 3	Qtr 4	2006 Totals
Gross Revenue	\$99,122	\$100,609	\$102,118	\$103,650	\$424,491

1. Create a pie chart based on the sample data above.




 Select a slice of the chart that you wish to pull out. e.g.) 'Qtr 4, \$103,650' (The round dots will appear around the slice, when it is ready to be pulled out.)





3. Drag the piece of the chart out.
