

Navigating within a worksheet

Microsoft Excel 2007

When you work with the keyboard, it will give you more control and work more efficiently. It may also help prevent OOS from using the mouse too much.

Navigation keys (right, left, top or down)

Navigation keys move one cell in a worksheet.



Page Up

Scrolling the document up one screen in a worksheet.



Page Down

Scrolling the document down one screen in a worksheet.



Home

Moves to the beginning of row in a worksheet



CTRL + Home



CTRL (control) and HOME keys will take you back to the beginning of the spreadsheet (A1).
