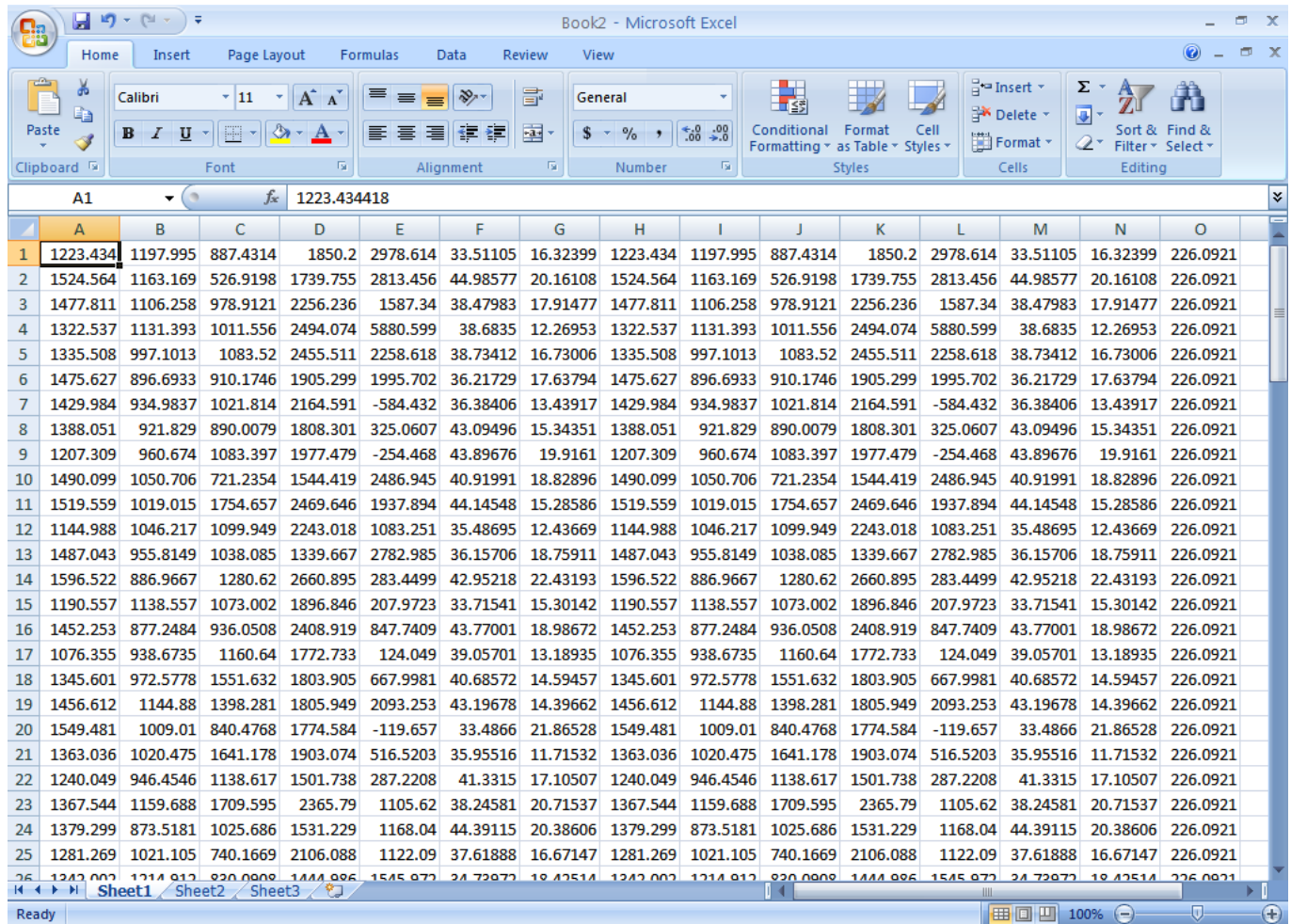


# Selecting a large area of data

## Microsoft Excel 2007

This is useful when you are dealing with a large area of data like below. You cannot see all of the data from the view below. You have to scroll down to the bottom. It can be difficult to select large amount of data like this using your mouse.



1. Select the top left cell where the data starts
