


Status bar

Microsoft Excel


Here are some tips for the status bar. It is located at the bottom of the Excel window. When multiple cells are selected, the Status Bar will provide information on these cells automatically.

Status Bar

Average	The average value in the cells selected.
Count	The number of selected cells that have data in them.
Numerical Count	The number of selected cells that contain numbers.
Max	The highest value in the cells selected.
Min	The lowest value in the cells selected.
Sum	The sum of the contents of the selected cells.

This will be handy to count how many items I've got!
